JOB POSTING – PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE

North Peace Tribal Council is seeking a Registered Nurse to join our team as a Public Health Nurse to develop and deliver comprehensive health programs based on the core functions of public health: population health assessment; health surveillance; disease and injury prevention; health promotion and health protection, including promoting, protecting and preserving the health of Dene Tha' First Nations people in Bushie River and Meander River. As an integral part of the team, you will carry out a full scope of practice and provide a broad range of services unique to northern nursing with North Peace Tribal Council. You will work alongside a talented team of nurses, other health professionals, and community members dedicated to delivering quality care in a culturally safe way.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist in the monitoring of the health status of individuals and families and develop appropriate health plans.
- Assist with the development of program work plans that support individual and community health efforts, and communicate the work plans to the public and other community agencies. This also includes planning and managing a client caseload, including coordination of intra- and inter-agency services.
- Providing population-based public health nursing services in schools, homes, clinics, community health fairs, and other settings in the community. This also includes providing services aimed at the promotion of health and the prevention of disease in individuals, families, and groups.
- Participate in the evaluation of the effectiveness, accessibility, and quality of personal health services. This includes accurate and appropriate documentation of individual and family interventions.
- Assure access to primary health care for all Bushie River and Meander River residents through referral.

Qualifications:

- Current CARNA licensed/registered in Alberta
- Applies knowledge, skills, judgment and competencies required for safe, independent and inter-disciplinary practice by meeting nursing practice standards as outlined by CARNA and related professional associations
- Proficiency with Microsoft Office programs

Additional Requirements:

- Current Criminal Records Check and Vulnerable Sector and Child Intervention Checks
- Current Valid Class 5 License
- Previous experience working with Indigenous First Nation communities would be an asset.
