- Provide public health and or education programs including but not limited to: Well Baby Clinics, STI Counseling, Prenatal/Postnatal care, and other public health programs.
- Provide Immunizations and assist the team with immunization clinics.
- Organize and jointly assist health providers and other health professionals with screening clinics.
- Make client/family home visits and referrals to other agencies and professionals when a need is identified.
- Create and maintain daily accurate records, documents, and reports.
- Participate in Community Health Program planning.
